### Day 3. Beijing (American Breakfast)

This morning, you will sight-see Tiananmen Square, which is noted as the largest public square in the world and then the Imperial Palace in the Forbidden City. The Forbidden City was the Chinese imperial palace from the Ming dynasty to the end of the Qing dynasty. For almost 500 years, it served as the home of emperors and their households, as well as the ceremonial and political center of Chinese government. Later stop at a Pearl Factory to gain a little knowledge of fresh pearls. In the afternoon, visit Summer Palace declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1998.

### Day 4. Beijing (American Breakfast, Lunch)

The Great Wall of China is one of the seven greatest man-made wonders of the world and is definitely the focal point of China. You will hike along the Great Wall (Juyongguan Pass). After that, you will stop at a Jade Museum to learn the history of Jade. In Chinese, Jade is pronounced as 'Yu', and it has a history in China of at least four thousand years. Later visit Traditional Chinese Medicine Center.

Optional Program: The Golden Mask Dynasty Show \$49 per person.

### Day 5. Beijing - Jinan (American Breakfast, Lunch)

This morning you will be transferred to train station for a two hours high speed train to Jinan, the capital of Shandong Province, the history of Jinan could be traced back to more than 5,000 years

ago. You will visit the Black Tiger Spring, is ranked as the second most significant among the 72 named springs in Jinan (after the Baotu Spring). Later tour Daming Lake is the largest lake in the city and one of city's main natural and cultural landmarks. Enjoy the picturesque scenery.

#### **Day 6. Jinan - Qufu (American Breakfast, Lunch)**

In the morning, we will drive to Qufu, which is best known as the hometown of Confucius. The city contains numerous historic palaces, temples and cemeteries. You will visit the Temple of Confucius in the morning, afternoon is free on your own to explore the city.

Half Day Optional Program: visiting the Cemetery of Confucius and the Kong Family Mansion at \$39 per person.

#### **Day 7. Qufu - Suzhou (American Breakfast, Lunch)**

Participating Qufu Gate Opening Ceremony in the morning, then take high speed train to Suzhou, which will take about 3 hours.

Optional Program: Boat ride on the Grand Canal with walk around the local neighborhood \$29 per person

**Hotel:** Pan Pacific Suzhou ★★★★★ or similar

#### **Day 8. Suzhou - Hangzhou (American Breakfast, Lunch)**

Today you will visit the Linger Garden and Silk Spinning Factory. The Linger Garden is a renowned classical Chinese garden and is recognized with other classical Suzhou gardens as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. China is known for its silk, so for sure we will take you to the Silk Spinning Factory. Then, we'll drive to Hangzhou. Take a small boat ride on the West Lake which reveals the ethereal beauty of Hangzhou's willow draped islands. You will admire the Su Causeway which was built in the Northern Song Dynasty (1090) and has evolved since then. At that time, Su Shi (Dongpo), a poet known as the prefect in Hangzhou Prefecture, had the West Lake dredged, and built the Su Causeway by dredged silt.

**Hotel:** Hangzhou Merchant Marco Garden Hotel ★★★★★ or similar

#### **Day 9. Hangzhou - Shanghai (American Breakfast, Lunch)**

After a stop at the Green Tea Village we will then drive you to Shanghai to visit the Bund. Shanghai is divided by the Huang Pu River into eastern and western sections. Modern mega high rises are seen on the eastern side while traditional European style architecture may be seen on the western side. The Bund is a five-block riverfront promenade with many of Shanghai's banks and trading houses.

Optional Program: Shanghai Lujiazui FTDZ & Huang Pu River Cruise \$45 per person.
